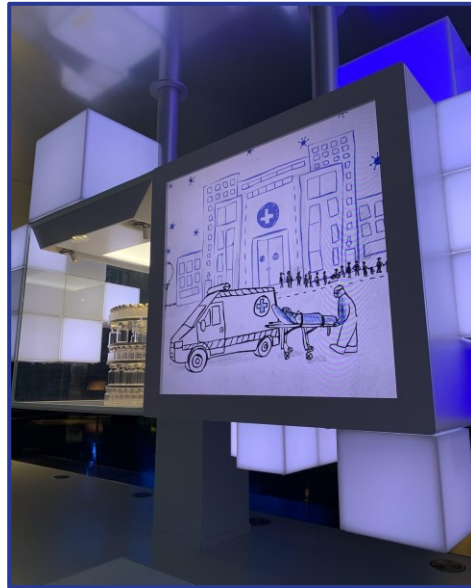
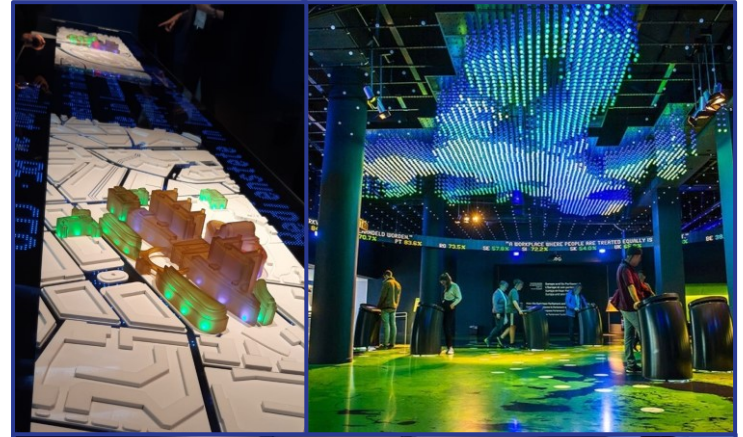
He has been a Member of the European Parliament since 1999 and a Vice-President of the European Parliament from 2012 to 2014 and again since July 2019

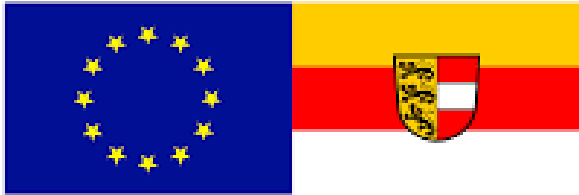

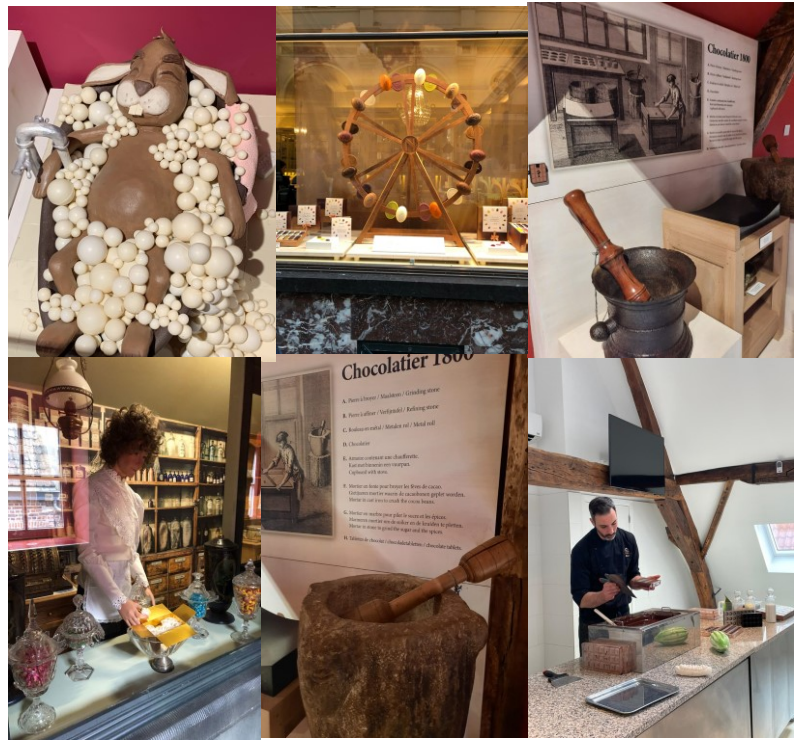

The first chocolate manufacturers saw the light of the day at the beginning of the 17th century in what is now the country of Belgium







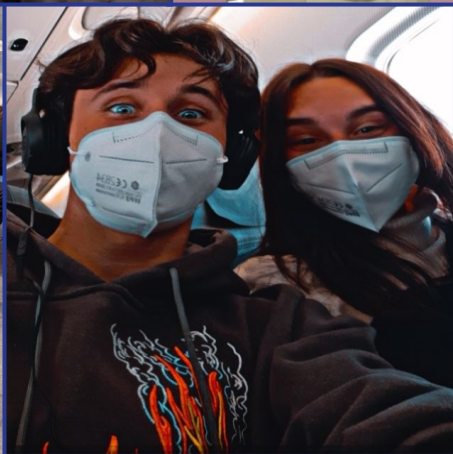
